

What's new in PCR version 11 (March 2016)

OVERVIEW

PCR version 11 has been updated to allow users to view core service registration information. The status information is obtained from the Patient Registration Service and refreshed in PCR regularly. CMS information is refreshed daily and MAS information is refreshed weekly. New functions include totals on the pharmacy home, new reports and icons that indicate if a patient is CMS registered and/or MAS registered/lapsed.

[Note: while the core service registration functions are implemented in PCR, the registration status data information from the Patient Registration System is currently not available but will be available soon. Further communication about this will be provided.]

All core service report information is taken from the information obtained from PRS. Different reports exist to distinguish where the data from PRS matches patients that already have a PCR record and where no pre-existing PCR record exists.

The report: 'CMS registered patients with initial assessment complete NOT set' includes a "days since registration" column that is intended to assist with prioritisation of initial assessments still to be done.

Only a total is shown for reports that contain information relating to MAS lapsed patients - there is no link to report detail.

This report shows the patient name, date of birth, CHI, gender, Post code, registration status effective from date, PRS extract received date, create patient link

The create patient link will prepopulate the add patient screen with the known information from PRS. While this function (also present for other "NO record in PCR" reports) can be used it is strongly recommended to use the PMR to PCR link to create the patient to ensure the most up-to-date information from your PMR is used to create the record. (PRS holds the patient details

from when the patient was first registered which may have been some time ago.)
