Just in Case (JIC) Boxes

Just in Case (JIC) Boxes contain anticipatory medicines for symptom management in palliative patients. The JIC box should be put in place prior to the patient becoming symptomatic to ensure timely access to medicines. If required these medicines can then be administered by attending health care professionals including during the out-of-hours period.

JIC boxes can be issued to any palliative patient by their GP practice or Hospital at Home. The prescriptions are taken to one of the NHS Fife Palliative Care Network Community Pharmacies along with a completed NHS Fife Anticipatory Medicines kardex. The pharmacy will dispense the medicines in the JIC box system along with sundries required for administration. The box is then placed in the patients home ready for use if required. The community pharmacy will ensure medicines remain in date and that the box is still required on a three monthly basis.

JIC boxes contain medicines for the following symptoms:

Pain	Morphine Sulphate or Oxycodone injection
Nausea and Vomiting	Levomepromazine or Cyclizine injection
Restless and Agitation	Midazolam injection
Respiratory Secretions	Hyoscine Butylbromide injection
Breathlessness	Morphine sulphate or Oxycodone injection
Terminal haemorrhage*	Midazolam injection**

*At prescribers discretion for high risk patients **NB different route and dose to that used for restlessness and agitation

Oxygen Concentrators

NHS Fife Pharmacy is able to supply an oxygen concentrator within 4 hours where it is required in an emergency for a palliative care patient at the end of life. Contact. 01383 565351 (office hours) and see Standard Operating Procedure (P6-8) that is available in all GP Practice. In the out-of-hours period, Urgent Care Services Fife have access to oxygen concentrators for emergency short term loan for this purpose also.

Community **Pharmacy Network**



The overall aim of this service is to provide a network of community pharmacists throughout Fife, who are able to meet the pharmaceutical care needs of palliative care patients.

Service Description

The following key services are provided:

- Dispensing of specialist palliative care medicines, according to an approved list.
- Provision of advice and information on the use of these medicines to patients/carers and healthcare professionals.
- Liaison with the patient's usual community pharmacist (chemist) and primary health care team to ensure continuity of supply of medicines and advice.
- Just In Case Boxes

Specialist Advice

- Palliative care network pharmacists receive specialist training in palliative care, with regular updates.
- Enquiries are welcomed regarding drug compatibility in syringe drivers; side-effects of treatment; problems in administration of medicines.

How to use the Service During Working Hours

When a patient is prescribed a specialist palliative care medicine, which is **required that day**: the patient's usual community pharmacy may not stock that medicine. If it is included in the stock list then refer the patient to the nearest Palliative Care Community Pharmacist (see list overleaf) who will:

- Dispense the initial prescription, and give the carer/ patient advice on the medicines (where appropriate).
- Refer the patient back to their usual pharmacist for further supplies (if required), once they make an assessment of their ongoing pharmaceutical needs. (This may require liaison with the patient's GP/district nurse).

Out-of-Hours Access - for urgent prescriptions only

If a prescription for a palliative care medicine is needed when the pharmacy is closed, contact the Urgent Care Services Fife healthcare professional line on **01592 740231**.

Some palliative care medicines listed are also stocked at the local Urgent Care Services Fife centre. If a medicine is not stocked there, then the Urgent Care Services Fife centre will contact a network pharmacy on your behalf.

For medicines not available from the Urgent Care Services Fife centre or network pharmacy, Urgent Care Services Fife will contact the hospital pharmacist on-call for advice.

Specialist Palliative Care Medicines

All medicines below (except Octreotide and Levomepromazine) are held in each of the pharmacies listed in this leaflet.

Levomepromazine 6mg is unlicensed and is used in patients with nausea and/or vomiting where the 25mg strength causes adverse effects (e.g. drowsiness) even when the tablet is halved.

Octreotide is used in a syringe driver, and can be useful for patients vomiting with GI obstruction. As both can be required urgently, for patients in the community, and in order to ensure access to and availability of these drugs, 3 pharmacies (1 in East, West and Central Fife area) routinely stock a supply of each.
