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Vaccination Services

COVID-19 Service

Bridging Contraception PGD Returns

The sexual health service are advertising on their website that eligible patients may obtain POP contraceptive from community pharmacies. Please ensure you have all completed the required training and have returned your authorisation forms for the desogestrel PGD.

The Community Pharmacy NSAIDs Advice and Care Bundle Survey

Controlled Drugs Team Update<u>Fraudulent Private Prescriptions</u>

The NHS Grampian CD Team have been made aware of fraudulent private prescriptions being presented at a number of community pharmacies in multiple other boards across Scotland over the last 48 hours.

Please be vigilant when presented with any private prescriptions and ensure you confirm authenticity before dispensing. Should you find that any prescription is not genuine, this should be reported to the police.

Substance Misuse Update Naloxone for Emergency Administration

A suspected overdose occurred in Grampian this week in a public location. A member of NHSG staff ran to their nearest pharmacy to get a supply of naloxone but the pharmacy had none. A close-by second pharmacy did. Community pharmacies are being promoted as a service that hold naloxone for emergency use, therefore please ensure you have stock.

There have been reports of Nyxoid being out of stock at local wholesalers this week. NAPP have reassured us that there is no shortage. It is likely that this means it is a local wholesaler issue. Please follow this up with the wholesaler and let the SMS team know if this issue continues: gram.smspharmacists@nhs.scot
