Substance Use Service

Please note that the Substance Misuse Service (SMS) has been renamed as the Substance Use Service (SUS) and will be referred to as such moving forward.

Non-Medical Prescribers Barcoded Prescription Forms – Vision Update

An updated version of Vision is currently being rolled out and is live in some GP practices. There have been issues identified where the end date does not print on instalment prescriptions despite being added in on the system.

We are working with Vision to understand and rectify the issues but in the meantime just a reminder that an end date is not a legal requirement on a prescription and included as good practice so any prescriptions that are presented without an end date can be dispensed as normal.

Thanks to all who have signed up to be Public Health Champions for your pharmacy. You should all have received a welcome email and it would be really useful if you could quickly reply so we know you've received, read and understood it.

Pharmacies who have not allocated a PH Champion can still do so if you wish, it really is just a point of contact for communications around smoking cessation and health promotion. If you don't nominate a PH Champion, you will still receive updates via the newsletter and on our website pages but not in a direct email, so it's even more important to check these communication channels regularly.

Smoking Cessation CO Monitoring Update

You may be aware that some NHS boards have resumed carbon monoxide monitoring. After some discussion, NHS Grampian have advised, due to costs and ongoing infection control issues, you should NOT recommence carbon monoxide monitoring at the present time. This will be reviewed within 6 months and we will update you on any further changes.
