# UNPLANNED CLOSURES IN COMMUNITY PHARMACY

- Advice and actions for community pharmacies

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#### **BACKGROUND**

In exceptional circumstances (out with your control) you may have to close your pharmacy for a portion of the day.

**It's important** that you inform the health board as soon **as possible if you think you will need to close** during your regular contracted hours.

If your pharmacy **DOES** have to close unexpectedly (for any more than 30 minutes) it is <u>essential</u> that you inform NHS Fife Primary Care Department of this closure, and the reason for this.

Contacting colleagues at <a href="mailto:fife.primarycareadmin@nhs.scot">fife.primarycareadmin@nhs.scot</a> (or by calling **01592 226 930**) will allow the opportunity to provide advice and support and sets into motion a chain of communication within the health board in an effort to mitigate and minimise the impact on other services and our patients.

To emphasise the importance of communicating both potential and actual closures as early as possible this communication pathway is shared in figure 1 below [n.b steps 1-4 occur during potential/partial closures and steps 5-6 occur only if a closure is not averted and the community pharmacy will be closed for a whole day].


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figure 1.0 – Chain of communication; community pharmacy closures



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Whilst we would not anticipate/hope that closures happen regularly, please follow the actions below should you be in a position where your pharmacy either:

- faces a **potential closure** out with your control [e.g unable to source locum cover]
- is **closed unexpectedly** [e.g responsible pharmacist is absent due to sickness]

[n.b please ensure that all relevant support staff are aware of this procedure too].

#### **ESSENTIAL ACTIONS REQUIRED:**

1. Inform NHS Fife Primary Care Department of the closure/potential closure and the reason for this.

- 2. Use your own business continuity plan to make alternative arrangements for all relevant patients (e.g daily dispensed/controlled drug medication, Monitored Compartmental Aids [MCA], deliveries etc) and alert them in advance. To make alternative arrangements for addiction services patients please contact addiction services directly on 01592 716446 first or alternatively by e-mailing <a href="Fife.addictionservicesadmin@nhs.scot">Fife.addictionservicesadmin@nhs.scot</a> giving full details and a return contact phone number [more information on missed doses here].
- 3. n.b If you are **unable to contact a patient**, the prescriber **must be** informed that the patient has not collected their medication for that day
- 4. If closed/closing and there is a member of staff in the pharmacy, display this sign on the window informing patients of the nearest open pharmacy (where core services are available).
- 5. inform your surrounding GP surgeries and local community pharmacies.

This will ensure that NHS 24, NHS inform and NHS Fife Out of Hours services are aware of your closure and will not direct patients to your pharmacy during the times you have highlighted.
