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Suicide Prevention Training Dates 2023

The North East Suicide Prevention Team are pleased to offer new training sessions for the Introduction to Suicide Prevention (ISP) and the Introduction to Youth Suicide Prevention (IYSP) throughout June and July 2023 to be hosted on Microsoft Teams as listed below.

Incidents Involving Patient Data

Please be reminded that when pharmacy incidents involve patient data, in addition to correcting the error for the patient which the wrong information was provided, it is important that the patient whose data was shared is notified. E.g. where a medication is handed to the incorrect patient, both patients should be notified of this error and the incident managed accordingly.

Holiday Healthcare

Patients visiting Scotland from a country in the European Economic Area, or Switzerland, will not have to pay for healthcare, provided that they can produce a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). Please see the attached flyer for more information.

In addition to the above and attached information, please remind all staff in your pharmacy of the patient eligibility criteria for Pharmacy First, which is detailed in Annex B of the Service Spec available here.

Reminder: Patient GP Registration Assistance

A flower that only grew in York, is brought back from extinction after 30 years!

Extinct since 1991, the York groundsel managed to carry on thanks to a handful of seed that was shed from three potted specimens on a windowsill at the University of York. Stored at the Millennium Seed Bank in the Kew Gardens, botanists at Natural England organised a resurrection for the York groundsel after they received word the seeds were reaching the end of their lifespan

"It's a smiley, happy-looking yellow daisy and it's a species that we've got international responsibility for," said Alex Prendergast, a vascular plant senior specialist for Natural England. "It's also got an important value as a pollinator and nectar plant in the area because it flowers almost every month of the year."
