NEW: Gluten Free Food Service

This is a reminder that Grampian pharmacies are now available on the GFFS webpage for patients to print order requests and either bring or email to you at the pharmacy. Please see attached handout with screenshot of this process to help you support your patients.

This is a great resource which has a number of product images included, to minimise risk of incorrect product ordered and only lists items on our Grampian GFF Formulary. The webpage is publically available here: <u>https://www.scotlandglutenfree.org.uk/</u>

Step 1: Patient fills in postcode of pharmacy. This identifies the pharmacy as being in Grampian and will populate only the Grampian formulary for the patient. They also complete their personal details to calculate the number of units per month they are allowed to order.

Step 2: Patient creates their prescription by selecting the items they wish to order that month. Can filter by product type (bread / pasta / crackers / cereals etc.) or by brand. All products are clear on weight and unit calculation. Once item is placed in basket, a countdown of total units remaining is provided.

Step 3: Checkout. The screen then confirms the order completion which can then be downloaded as a PDF and printed / taken to pharmacy or emailed to the pharmacy.

Period Poverty

The Period Products (Free Provision) (Scotland) Act 2021 ("the Act") was passed by the Scottish Parliament on 24 November 2020 and received Royal Assent on 12 January 2021. Within *Aberdeen City*, <u>Community</u> <u>Food Initiatives North East</u> (CFINE) and <u>National Advisory Council on Women and Girls</u> (NACWG) can now provide free sanitary products to all pharmacies. CFINE will deliver the products straight to the pharmacy and you can subsequently order on-demand or set up an automatic repeat delivery system.

Britain is embracing refillable water bottles

According to the anti-disposables campaign <u>Refill</u>, just 20% of people in the UK used a refillable water bottle in 2015. However, that figure has now grown to almost 60%.

Working alongside more than 80 councils, and with a growing network of high street chains onboard, <u>the Refill app</u> showcases a network of 32,000 places across the UK – from municipal fountains to big chains and from pubs to independent shops or businesses – where people can top up their bottles for free, no questions asked.
