Obesity Action Scotland

Following the Scottish Health Survey (SHeS) which gathered information between 2016-2021, Obesity Action Scotland have published a suite of 14 regional obesity prevalence factsheets, one for each regional health board area in Scotland. The factsheets contain key facts and data on obesity trends for adults and children, maternal obesity, fruit and vegetable consumption, food insecurity, type 2 diabetes prevalence and levels of physical activity in each regional health board area and details how this compares to the national average/rate.

We've attached the factsheet for Grampian showing that 66% of Grampian's population are in an overweight or obese category. If you are keen to see other board's statistics as a comparison, you can find their information here.
