The UK Government has launched an 8 week consultation paper and is welcoming comments from all parents, teachers and health professionals. This consultation asks questions on proposed action to protect future generations from the harms of smoking, by creating the first smoke free generation. Inhaler Sustainability

Please be reminded to encourage patients to return all their empty inhalers to pharmacy which should be disposed of correctly for incineration. The guidance on arrangements for collection and disposal of Healthcare Waste can be viewed here and the attached poster can be shared with patients.

Circular PCA(P)(2023)38 - Extension to Serious Shortage Protocol (SSP) issued for Jext 300 micrograms/ 0.3mL.

This Circular advises community pharmacy contractors that the active Serious Shortage Protocol (SSP) for Jextil 90.00 micrograms 0.3mL, 11 in 1000) solution for specific on side-specific pen, an adrenatine auto-spector product one to expire on 20 october 2020, has now been extended until Friday 27 micros
