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Reminder: National Naloxone Service

This is a reminder that the national emergency supply naloxone service became live on 30th October. Participation in this service is mandatory for all contractors and you must all ensure you have completed the required training and have the correct stock available in your pharmacies. Community Pharmacy Delivery Scam Alert

This week you will have received an alert via email regarding a reported community pharmacy delivery scam. If you missed this, please be aware of the scam where patients are receiving phone calls from a London number asking for their bank details in order to secure on-going prescription deliveries.

You may wish to remind your delivery patients that you will never call asking for their bank details for a prescription delivery.

Coeliac Disease Training and Gluten Free Food Service

As part of the service specification for GGFS, all patients registered require to have an annual check at their pharmacy. Much of this can be done over the phone. You can run a report on your PCR to find any outstanding annual checks to be completed for your patients. In addition, in Grampian, the online ordering platform is available to all coeliac patients registered for GFFS. This platform only holds items on the Grampian GFF Formulary and ensures each patient only orders the units they are entitled to. A reminder that patients are required to input the postcode of their pharmacy to enter the site, not the postcode of their home.

Smoking Cessation

Smoking Data for Quarter 1, April - June 2023

The data is always 6 months behind. A comparison has been made with the same quarter from 2022 and shows some overall improvement over Grampian pharmacies:

- Sign-ups: VERY subtle rise from 829 to 838 people.
- Missed submissions at 4 weeks: fallen from 299 to 249 cases.
- Missed submissions at 12 weeks fallen from 86 (29%) to 6 (2%) Based on a percentage of 4 week successes continuing to 12 weeks.
- 12 week successful guits: rise from 117 to 179 cases. That's a 53% rise!

Well done everyone! A note of caution however. The total number of patients completing the whole 12 week course remains well under the national target which is to obtain 710 twelve week quits from the 40% lowest socioeconomic groups. If your submissions are problematic, it's likely your Public Health Practitioner will be in touch in due course to alert you and discuss any support you may require.

Please be reminded that capturing data is absolutely crucial. Using your PCR "reports function" every week will cut down on missed data. A Wednesday is the ideal time to capture data before national database collection (this will also avoid any issues with the same patient restarting before their previous attempt is captured).
