Paracetamol PGD

There has been much confusion regarding the paracetamol PGDs. We want to confirm that the PGD on NHS Grampian PGD page is for administration of paracetamol at the time of MenB injections only. This PGD has been removed from the CP website and all associated packs to avoid confusion.

Supplies of paracetamol for post vaccination fever from pharmacies via Pharmacy First are only licensed where the infant is at least 8 weeks old. If a child presents younger than 8 weeks, a clinician prescription will have to be issued by GP practice as this is out with the licensing of paracetamol liquid.
