Pharmacy First: Updated Guidance and Referral Form for Treatment of Minor Eye Conditions

With lots of information circulating social media regarding "know who to turn to" and using "pharmacy first", we wanted to remind you that treatment should only be supplied via the NHS Pharmacy First Scotland Service for patients with active symptoms, not for patients looking to stock up their medicine cupboards.

Community Pharmacy NHS Patient Group Directions (PGDs)

There are currently review dates on some of the NHS PGDs. Please note that review dates are not expiry dates; they are a note of the time window in which the review will take place. If the PGD is past its review date, the content will remain valid until such time as the PGD review is complete and the new issue published. PGDs with expiry dates will have these specifically stated.

The national PGDs for aciclovir and flucloxacillin for use under NHS Pharmacy First Scotland, and desogestrel for use under Public Health Service are currently under review – updated versions will be issued in 2024.
