What system do I use to claim for the service?	The Universal Claim Framework (UCF) should be used if a supply is made or if stock expires	NEO 360 should be used each time a supply and training is given
Is the service available in all community pharmacies in Fife?	Yes	Not currently. Participating pharmacies in Fife can be found below
Does this service cover supply of naloxone to people at risk and general public to take home for use in future emergency?	No. This service is for immediate emergency situations only	Yes
My pharmacy stock has expired, can I claim for reimbursement?	Yes – through UCF	No
Which service can I use to replace an expired naloxone kit belonging to a member of the public?	No. Signpost to your closest pharmacy participating in THN	Yes
A suspected opioid overdose is occurring outside the premises – which service do I use to make the supply?	Yes	No
Are staff expected to administer naloxone?	There is no expectation for staff to administer naloxone in an emergency situation. However, staff can administer if they feel competent	No. This is a 'take home' service
Should the supply of naloxone be recorded on the patient's PMR?	Yes , if these details are known. <u>For emergency supply</u> : only add to the PMR of the person who is overdosing	
A relative of a person at risk of an overdose would like a naloxone kit. Which service do I use to claim for the provision of a naloxone kit and the training?	No. Signpost to your closest pharmacy participating in THN	Yes
How many kits should I keep to support this service?	2 kits must be kept. This can be a mixture of Prenoxad and Nyxoid or can be two of the same	Recommend keeping 2 kits (in addition to 2 emergency kits)
