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| Freestyle Libre 3 Prescribing April 2024 Attached | Please see attached information regarding the introduction of Freestyle Libre 3 in GGC The key messages are: • Freestyle Libre 3 is a form of real-time continuous glucose monitoring with additional functionality that enables it to communicate directly with certain types of insulin pump. The trio of pump, installed software, and Freestyle Libre 3 is known as a hybrid closed loop (HCL) which provides semi-automated insulin delivery for people with type 1 diabetes. • Freestyle Libre 3 is a novel device and is not interchangeable with Freestyle Libre2 • Freestyle Libre 3 has been added to Part 3 of Scottish drug tariff from January 2024 Helen Castle Advanced Pharmacist (Primary Care) 25/04/2024 |
