



What is Give it Up for Baby?

Give it Up for Baby (GIUFB) is an incentive scheme for pregnant women who would like to give up smoking.

Who is eligible for GIUFB?

ALL pregnant women living in Tayside are eligible for GIUFB provided their carbon monoxide reading (CO) is 6 or higher.

Evidence of smoking status and initial CO reading will be accepted as follows:

- > CO reading written by Health Care Professional on NHS Tayside headed paper
- CO reading recorded on Free Yourself Reading Chart and signed by a Smoking Cessation Specialist

What do I do if a woman wants to register?

How does the scheme work?

- The woman will visit pharmacy every week for 12 weeks (excluding the first visit to sign up).
- Every time she has a reading of **4 or under and has not smoked that week** she will receive £12.50 credit for the participating supermarket.
- Payments will be made weekly for the first 12 weeks then every 4 weeks until 3 months after expected date of delivery.
- A GIUFB payment does not affect benefits.

A woman has previously joined the scheme and is now pregnant again. Can she join the scheme more than once?

Yes

A woman has previously been registered on the Quit4U incentive scheme. She has returned to smoking, can she now join GIUFB? Yes

The woman has had a miscarriage or a stillbirth, what happens to her payments? She can claim up until 3 months after expected date of delivery.
