COMMON CONDITIONS TREATABLE UNDER THE NHS PHARMACY FIRST SCOTLAND SERVICE:

This week we focus on....DRY SKIN!

Every Patient Interaction you should be recording on your PMR includes:

ADVICE such as: reduce frequency of showing or bathing, don't use highly scented or perfumed products, apply emollients after bathing or showering and twice daily, drink plenty of water, apply steroid creams 30 mins after applying emollients

REFERRALS for patients with red, broken, weeping skin showing signs of infection, or skin not responding to treatment after 7-10 days after applying emollients at least twice daily

2 nd Line	Oilatum cream	Pack Sizes	150g, 500ml
2 nd Line	Zerodouble gel	Pack Sizes	100g, 500g
