COMMON CONDITIONS TREATABLE UNDER THE NHS PHARMACY FIRST SCOTLAND SERVICE:

This week we focus on....**NAPPY RASH!**

Every Patient Interaction you should be recording on your PMR includes:

ADVICE such as: change nappies frequently, lots of 'no nappy' time to let skin breathe, check if brand of nappy being used has changed recently (some babies react to certain brands)

REFERRALS you need to make for patients with broken, red, weeping skin showing signs of infection
