COMMON CONDITIONS TREATABLE UNDER THE NHS PHARMACY FIRST SCOTLAND SERVICE:

This week we focus on....CONTACT DERMATITIS!

Every Patient Interaction you should be recording on your PMR includes:

ADVICE such as: remove items which cause the allergy e.g. watch, rings, earrings; apply emollients first then apply any steroid creams 30 minutes later.

REFERRALS you need to make for patients with multiple areas of red, broken weeping skin, or signs of infection, or not responding to treatment after 5-7 days.
