SUBMIT DATA BETWEEN days 28 - 42 on PCR



SUBMIT DATA BETWEEN weeks 10 -14 on PCR



Discharge from Pharmacy and congratulate



VERY BRIEF ADVICE (V. B. A.)



ASK:

Establish and Record Smoking Status "Do you Smoke?" / "Are you Still Smoking?"

ADVISE:

How to Stop

"The best way to stop is with Support and Treatment"

ACT:

Offer Support and Treatment "When you are ready just make an appointment with...."

First Line Treatment

Varenicline tablets

500micrograms, 1mg (Champix)



Nicotine patch

7mg, 14mg, or 21mg over 24 hours (Nicotinell® TTS)

Nicotine Lozenges

1.5mg, 4mg (Niquitin® minis), 2mg (Nicotinell®)

Nicotine chewing gum

2mg, 4mg (Nicotinell®)

N.B. When using NRT products always think Nicotinell!!!!



Pharmacy Care Record (PCR) Guide lines.



Before starting an assessment check the following:





- Select the patient and create a record for the patient.
- Date of Birth: Please ensure this is entered correctly.
- Address: Insert full postal address.
- Full Postal Code: Please ensure this is entered correctly.
- Contact phone number/e-mail address(<u>not</u> Pharmacy details).
- If a patient has no CHI, refer to Stop Smoking Service (QYW).

Submission of data sets on PCR



After each submission check:

Status is shown as 'Validated' Release Status as 'Submitted'



Prior to releasing the 4 week and 12 weeks:

Update the PCR with product use How many weeks of treatment given


Always check reports at least once a week:

Submit between 4 and 6 weeks
Submit between 10 and 14 weeks



Common Errors with PCR

- Entering pharmacy Tel. No. instead of clients
- Making quit date too far in advance (> 14 days)
- Making two entries for same client
- Missing submission deadlines
- Not updating Initial Data page





Frequently Asked Questions







Can we support a clients on an E Cigarette? Refer these patients to QYW specialist service.

Can we re-start a client who has recently failed?
Use your professional judgment restart if committed.





Can we prescribe in pregnancy/breast feeding?
Best to signpost to QYW, but we can support too.

Can we prescribe where there are complex health issues? Best to signpost to QYW, but we can support too.





Can we prescribe where there are Issues of Cannabis Use? Best to signpost to QYW, but we can support too.

Can we prescribe NRT for Young People? We can support any one over 12 years old.





Can clients use the service to cut down? This is a stop smoking service only.

Can we reopen a PCR record that has been closed in error?

Specialist Service Quit Your Way (QYW) Referral Pathway



QYW emails
Prescription
request letter to
GP Practice
pharmacist (PP)
for Varenicline



PP prescribe varenicline via GP10



CP dispenses varenicline script



QYW emails a product request form to CP for NRT



CP prescribes NRT via UCF as per QYW request



NB:
CP DO NOT perform
CO tests or put
these clients on PCR

Community Pharmacy (CP) Pathway

Client presents at CP Discuss

1st line LJF treatment either Varenicline or NRT

(NB.Think Nicotinell products only)



Client attends WEEKLY as before perform CO tests and update PCR, prescribe via UCF

Four Week Follow Up SUBMIT DATA BETWEEN DAYS 28 AND 42 on PCR for all clients i.e. successful, unsuccessful and lost to follow up. Only smoke free clients can continue with the service. Update initial capture details. Initiates 2nd Remuneration of £15

Twelve Week follow up SUBMIT DATA BETWEEN weeks 10 -14 on PCR, for all clients i.e. successful, unsuccessful and lost to follow up. Update initial capture details. Initiates 3rd Remuneration of £35
