| | 2. Medicines have been spilled, dropped or inadvertently destroyed |
| | As there is an immediate need. |
| | In the case where a resident's medicines are no longer in sync (i.e. the current supply will not last until the end of the cycle e.g. due to a hospital admission, commencement mid- |

| cycle) the criteria for the Unscheduled Care PGD are not met. NHS 24 (the authors of the PGD) have advised that it should not be used for this purpose. |

| In this situation a prescription from their GP is required, this can either be: |
