#### This Weeks Key Messages

#### Area Pharmacy Professional Committee – repeat message

There are currently vacancies for two community pharmacists (one from East, and one from South Ayrshire H&SCP areas).

The APPC is one of NHS Ayrshire and Arran's professional advisory committees and provides pharmacy-specific advice to the board on a range of healthcare issues affecting the local population. The committee is made up of representatives from community, hospital and primary care pharmacy services. The committee is co-chaired by Iain Fulton (from primary & community care) and Annmarie Crow (operational services manager - acute pharmacy).

We meet 6 times per year, normally for two hours alternating morning/evening every 8 to 9 weeks. An attendance fee is payable and will be paid to your contractor as a sessional rate (£175 per meeting). At a time when we are looking to transform health and care services across Ayrshire & Arran through the Caring for Ayrshire vision, our professional committees will have a key role to play as we explore new and innovative ways of designing and delivering healthcare services for our citizens.

As well as the opportunity to influence and input, membership of the APPC also provides an opportunity to build and enhance your professional network within the health board. Our Director of Pharmacy regularly attends the meetings and there are often guest speakers invited who present on their area of innovation and/or expertise.
