

Guide Prices for Commonly Requested Unlicensed Medicines

Effective from 1st August 2020, any patient presenting with a prescription for the items below, please use the prices and information below to procure and endorse unlicensed specials or imports. If you can obtain at this price or lower, you do not need to seek authorisation.

The prices on the pre-approved guide price list are to provide a maximum cost where the Board are happy to approve without prior authorisation; these do not and should not replace the invoice price submitted for payment. Pharmacy teams must ensure that the item is correctly endorsed electronically (and on paper) as per invoice price and not as listed below.

NB Updated circular in respect to Special preparations issued April 2023, items in the tariff which are solution or suspension, cream or ointment the terms are interchangeable and no longer require separate authorisation [PCA2023\(P\)17.pdf \(scot.nhs.uk\)](https://www.scot.nhs.uk/PCA2023(P)17.pdf)

NB Epistatus: all pre filled syringes are now licensed products and no longer listed in the Scottish Drug Tariff Epistatus 10mg/1ml 5ml (multi-dose) bottle remains unlicensed.
