

Gluten Free Prescriptions-Information for patients

Following a confirmed diagnosis of Coeliac Disease or Dermatitis Herpetiformis (DH), people in Scotland can register at their local pharmacy to receive gluten free food 'staples' on prescription.

Your Doctor or Dietitian will complete a form for you to take to a local pharmacy of your choice, and the Pharmacist will help you to order gluten free food.

Your monthly prescription allowance for these products is based on your calorie requirements and is recorded in units-as listed in the table below:

Age group	Suggested number of units per month
Child 1- 3 years	10
Child 4 – 6 years	11
Child 7 -10 years	13
Child 11- 14 years	15
Child 15 – 18 years	18
Male 19 -59	18
Male 60 -74	16
Male 75 + years	14
Female 19 -74 years	14
Female 75 + years	12
Breastfeeding	Add 4 units
3 rd trimester pregnancy	Add 1 unit

Remember there are many naturally gluten free foods. For example:

- All fresh fruits and vegetables are gluten free*
- All fresh meat, poultry, fish and eggs are gluten free*
- All fresh milk, plain yogurts and most cheeses are gluten free*
- Potatoes, rice, and a variety of breakfast cereals are gluten free*

*Always check the food label for wheat, barley and /or rye for foods that have been processed in any way.

Most supermarkets now stock 'free from' ranges. Speak with your Dietitian or Coeliac UK for further information and support.

The products listed below are approved for prescribing for individuals with Coeliac Disease or Dermatitis Herpetiformis in Dumfries & Galloway.

Please note:

- Some products are fortified with vitamins and minerals, please ask your dietitian or pharmacist for more information
- Some products contain Codex wheat starch, highlighted with a circle (•), an ingredient that is safe for people with coeliac disease.
- For the pharmacy: When ordering a gluten free product please ensure you select a wholesaler who will not charge out of pocket expenses or please order directly from the manufacturer.
