The following naloxone kits can be used for both services:

- Naloxone 1.26mg/0.1ml nasal spray, commonly known as The Pebble.
- Nyxoid 1.8mg/0.1ml nasal spray.
- **Prenoxad 2mg/2ml intramuscular injection.** *should <u>always</u> be ordered as **Prenoxad** and not generic naloxone 2mg/2ml.
