

## Pre-approved Price List for Commonly Requested Unlicensed Medicines

The prices on the pre-approved guide price list are to provide a maximum cost where the Board are happy to approve without prior authorisation; these do not and should not replace the invoice price submitted for payment. Pharmacy teams must ensure that the item is correctly endorsed electronically (and on paper) as per invoice price and not as listed below.

Handling/delivery/Out of Pocket expenses are for the consideration of the community Pharmacy and are not included in the specials cost authorisation process.

If the guide price provided cannot be met or if the drug prescribed is not on the list below, then **authorisation will be required**. In these situations, please submit a request via the [eForm](#).

Community pharmacies are **not** required to obtain prior authorisation for **Clonazepam injection** if the request is for general stock as part of the **palliative care network**. However, if the request is for a named patient and the pharmacy is not part of the palliative care network, prior authorisation must be submitted.
