About this work

- Highly targeted engagement activity with 20-25 people in Scotland
- Individual interviews taking place until June 2025 in person/telephone/videocall
- Looking to speak to people who are:
 - currently taking Valproate or have stopped taking Valproate since August 2023 for any condition
 - living in Scotland within the above period
 - people able to become pregnant or get someone pregnant if not on contraception
 - between 12-55 years old
 - or, carers of people with the above characteristics
- Engagement till end of June
- Final report to be published in early autumn

About this work

- Wide circulation of materials and information e.g. third sector, posters in pharmacies
- Aiming to hear from a diverse group of people with lived experience and/or their carers
- Questions include:
 - when patients started taking Valproate, how that worked and information when starting
 - thoughts on the prescription and annual process
 - thoughts about how to improve the overall experience of taking Valproate and information received
 - what matters most about their experience with Valproate, and
 - thoughts about taking Valproate in future
- Equality monitoring
