## ▲ Recent Drug Alert

'Significantly harmful heroin potentially contaminated with a suspected nitazine (synthetic opioid) causing rapid respiratory failure and unconsciousness. Potentially mixed in with other substances eg crack'

- Always have naloxone; don't use alone, go slow, go low
- Always call an ambulance encourage people! The call handler will talk you through how to administer naloxone and what basic first aid to do

#### Naloxone Awareness

- Naloxone reverses opioid overdose, safe
- Available as nasal spray or injection,
- Available to anyone at risk, families, services
