Please find attached V3 of the NHS Grampian ADHD statement. The content of this statement has been reviewed and this principles remain the same due to the ongoing stock situation as well as ongoing patient pathway discussions. This will be reviewed again by 1st February 2025.

Public Health Service Updated Service Documentation for Emergency and Bridging Contraception

The attached circular advises Health Boards and community pharmacy contractors of an updated Patient Group Direction (PGD) that is to be implemented for the provision of desogestrel as bridging contraception. It also encloses updated service specifications for both the emergency hormonal contraception (EHC) and bridging contraception (BC) services as well as supporting guidance.
