Please be reminded that Varenicline has been reintroduced but is not yet available to use as part of the smoking cessation programme in Scotland. Realistically it will be into next year that we receive the updated PGD, which is currently being updated at a national level and staff will require some training on it once finalised. We may also need to wait until enough stocks become available.

In the meantime, we advise that you continue to use the NRT products available as part of the 12 week programme. We'll keep you posted as things evolve.
