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For Action: Travel Health – Private Provision

As detailed within the attached letter sent to all community pharmacies on 13th December, the public health team are currently finalising the website that will be available for the new travel health service following cessation of the service in community pharmacies on 31st January 2025. They would like to be able to signpost patients to pharmacies who are offering private travel health services.

Coming Soon – Green Bag Relaunch

NHS Grampian's Realistic Medicine team are supporting the relaunch of the Green Bag scheme. This is to encourage patients to bring their own medication into hospital which has multiple benefits including:

- Encouraging patient independence to continue self-managing their medication
- Improving medication reconciliation
- Reduction of waste from re-dispensing medicines unnecessarily
- Reduction of prescribing errors and missed doses
- Speedier admissions and discharge process
- Improving communication between the different professionals involved in one person's care

This will be relaunched in the New Year. Community pharmacies will receive some promotional materials and a small stock of green bags to issue to patients. This will come with ordering instructions to allow further bags to be ordered (via the resources database). NES Pharmacy: Physical Assessment Skills Training

Over the last 12 months, NES have been supporting a network of Designated Supervisor's (DS) to increase their confidence in the use of physical assessment skills and their ability to assess trainee pharmacists utilising these skills in practice.
