Agency Referrals

We have received reports that agency referral prescriptions received via email at community pharmacies from GMEDs, are not always arriving at community pharmacies via post. Although this is not common, we have discussed the process that should be followed, should this happen.

If you receive a prescription from GMEDs via the agency referral process, and have not received the original prescription within **one week**, you should send an email to gram.gmedurgent@nhs.scot, along with a scanned copy of the agency referral you received. A member of the GMEDs team will chase this prescription, and ensure you receive it.

Opening New PCR Files

You may remember that there were some updates to the PCR system last year. One of these changes was that you could open multiple files for the same patient to allow easy transfer between pharmacies.

Unfortunately the National ISD system is not compatible with these changes and therefore we ask you all to defer back to the previous system. Therefore PLEASE DO NOT OPEN A NEW PCR FILE FOR YOUR PATIENT UNTIL THE FOLLOWING WEEK (a Thursday must pass for National upload). Opening 2 files may result in missed payment.
