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Community Pharmacy Controlled Drugs Incidents

A report was sent to community pharmacies by the CD team at the end of 2024, detailing the types of CD dispensing errors that have been reported. The top three incidents reported were:

- Dispensing errors
- Handout errors
- Unexplained loss/missing controlled drugs

We continue to see errors reported due to incorrect pack sizes being dispensed. Please be extra vigilant when dispensing original packs, as they often contain 30 as opposed to 28 solid oral dosage forms and this is frequently cited as the source of the error.

Supporting Children and Young People with Health Care Needs and Managing Medicines in Educational Establishments

Please find attached the updated guidance which now includes specific guidance around the appropriate use of the Pharmacy First service. This would be a useful reference to use, should you have any queries regarding supplies for school trips.

Buprenorphine Prescribing Switch

NHS Grampian are enacting a prescribing switch for patients receiving oral Buprenorphine products for opioid dependency. Attached is a community pharmacy leaflet which explains the rationale behind this switch and the actions for community pharmacies. There is also a patient leaflet attached which is for reference and can be given to patients for further information. Please ensure all community pharmacy staff members read the community pharmacy leaflet and action all relevant points.

Communication should be made to community pharmacies prior to Buprenorphine product changing by the patients prescriber/keyworker to allow time for pharmacy to order in the new Buprenorphine product, or prescriptions should be delivered to pharmacies in advance to allow new product to be ordered in time for prescription starting. Ban on Single Use Vapes

Back in October 2024, it was decided that from 1 June 2025, it will be illegal for businesses to sell or supply, offer to sell or supply, or have in their possession for sale or supply all single-use or 'disposable' vapes.

Single use vapes, when thrown away, damage our environment, cause fires in our waste streams, and place a significant financial burden on those who must clean up the mess.

NHS and NICE Recommended Apps

We'd like to draw your attention to two NHS recommended Apps which have recently been added to the NICE guidance and encouraged to be used in primary care as first-line treatments to insomnia and anxiety.

<u>Sleepio</u> and <u>Daylight</u> are science-backed digital therapies, personalised to your patients' needs - with no need for prescriptions or a doctor's appointment. <u>Sleepio</u> is an effective long-term solution to sleep difficulties and has now become a registered medical device. <u>Daylight</u> is an effective long-term solution for anxiety and worry. Both have been subject to many randomised controlled trials with positive results.
