Only one strength of these are out of stock, the other two strengths remain in limited supply. As such we are not recommending proactive identification and switching of patients. The attached information can be utilised in circumstances where timely supplies of capsules cannot be procured.

As you can see, unfortunately sign-ups in quarter 3 have fallen and missed 4-week submissions have risen. The percentage of 12-week quits remains at 21% which just falls short of Scotland's pharmacy national average of 22.9%.
