FreeStyle Libre Discontinuation - No Further Dispensing Episodes

As you will be aware from previous updates, FreeStyle Libre® 2 is being discontinued, with a move to FreeStyle Libre® 2 **Plus**. All practices in NHS Grampian have now enacted the necessary changes to prescribing to ensure all patients are being prescribed FreeStyle Libre® 2 **Plus**.

If community pharmacies receive a prescription for the discontinued FreeStyle Libre® 2 they are asked to contact the pharmacotherapy team at the patients GP practice and request a change to FreeStyle Libre® 2 **Plus**.

Smoking Cessation

PCR Common Error – Telephone Numbers

A reminder please that if you do not know the patient's phone number, DO NOT INSERT THE PHARMACY NUMBER, just put UNKNOWN. This error results in your PCR file not being successfully submitted to the National database and therefore payment will be void. Also a reminder to allow a week (a Thursday to pass) before opening a new PCR file for the same patient to avoid errors at the National database end and, again, void payments.
