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## PCA(P)(2025)20 – NHS Pharmacy First Scotland Updated PGD's

Please find attached NHS Circular PCA(P)(2025) 20 - Additional Pharmaceutical Services: NHS Pharmacy First Scotland - Updated PGDs.

Please note the email statement from the Antibiotic Pharmacists, sent along with the Pharmacy First PGD distribution contained an error, which has been corrected below:

### **UTI PGD updates**

Please note that the updated trimethoprim PGD for treatment of acute uncomplicated urinary tract infection now includes information (section 1.1) to highlight that antibiotics are not always required for women aged **under** 65 years who describe their symptoms as mild. Please continue to use the trimethoprim PGD to supply a first line antibiotic treatment when indicated. The new nitrofurantoin PGD provides an alternative antibiotic treatment option if trimethoprim is contraindicated eg due to allergy or a drug interaction.

#### Flu Vaccination Clinics

There is no offer of COVID vaccination to NHS/social care staff this year. All staff will need to attend a staff clinic or make an appointment at one of the vaccination centres.

There will not be staff queues/priority access to the public vaccination centres unless they happen to be hosting staff clinics.

Immunisation should be provided to healthcare and social care workers in direct contact with patients/clients to protect them and to reduce the transmission of influenza within health and social care premises, to contribute to the protection of individuals who may have a suboptimal response to their own immunisations, and to avoid disruption to services that provide their care. This would include health and social care staff directly involved in the care of their patients or clients.

Staff can attend clinics as drop in's and should bring staff ID. This is encouraged where possible as capacity may be reduced from October – November 2025, please see the attached staff clinics.
