Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC)

A Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC) is a nationally recognised process to identify how professionals can help victim-survivors at high risk of serious harm or death from domestic abuse.

Professionals hold regular local MARAC meetings to discuss cases. They discuss current concerns about a case and share information they have about a victim, any connected children and the perpetrator of the abuse.

The meeting formulates an action plan, which helps to reduce risks to the victim and their family.
