On 5th February, Public Health Scotland (PHS) issued two new drug alerts. Please find the attached important information and harm reduction advice for community pharmacy teams.

The current Mind to Mind campaign will run until the next campaign Re Think Dementia which will commence 24th February until the end of March. There is nothing confirmed yet for April but it looks likely that May will be Lyme disease again. Posters will arrive automatically.

Please also be reminded that No Smoking Day is on the 12th March, please step up promotion over that period. GOLD and SIMD project pharmacies (and anyone else who wants to get involved), please use your Very Brief Advice (VBA) algorithm to opportunistically capture smokers wishing to stop. 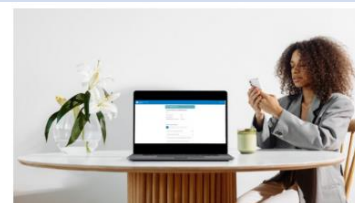
