



## ....Did you know?

## Haloperidol 500microgram tablets are an EXTREMELY HIGH COST ITEM

Haloperidol 500microgram tablets currently cost £368 per 28 tablets (£13.14 per tablet)\*.

This is significantly more expensive that other haloperidol strengths and formulations.

In the last 6 months\*\* NHS Grampian has spent **over £90k** on haloperidol 500microgram tablets. If this had been prescribed as haloperidol 200microgram/ml oral solution (costing approx. £15k) NHS Grampian could have **saved £75k/6months**.

## **ACTIONS**

SHARE – Ensure all prescribers are aware of this information STOP – prescribing haloperidol 500microgram tablets for new patients. Consider alternative formulations to provide appropriate clinical dose. REVIEW – Current patients prescribed haloperidol 500microgram tablets. Review ongoing need, and if still clinically indicated switch to the most cost-effective formulation/strength. Ensure patients/carers are made aware of any changes in formulation/strength or prescribed preparations.

If a patient requiring low dose haloperidol was prescribed haloperidol 200micrograms/ml oral solution rather than haloperidol 500microgram tablets this would generate a saving of £10.89 per 500microgram dose.

ONE haloperidol 500microgram tablet = 2.5mls haloperidol 200microrgam/ml oral solution

Saving £10.89 per dose

Alternative formulations of haloperidol which would represent cost effective prescribing options include:

Formulation	Pack size	Cost
200microgram/ml oral solution	100ml	£89.90
5mg/5ml oral solution	100ml	£12.00
10mg/5ml oral solution	100ml	£7.59
1.5mg tablets	28	£14.25
5mg tablets	28	£9.32

Formulation and strength suitability will be dependent on the clinical dose required.
